Ensure growth in development is supported by infrastructure and public services such as police, fire, medical and schools. Improve sustainable transport , particularly a safe cycle route between Taunton and Wellington. Encourage better, affordable bus routes in and around the town and between railway stations as developed.. Don't focus solely on rail transport, although this is highly desirable for the town. Sports provision is not targetted to keep pace with population growth so reserve sufficient land for additional sports facilities. Encourage 20 mph limits in residential areas. Further housing development should be on brownfield sites and ensure green spaces maintained. Bring back unused buildings into usage particularly Tonedale Mill, or have them demolished and new sustainable developments built with employment use attached.
